Pursuant to article 56, paragraph 1 point 1.2, article 59 paragraph 1, article 62, of the law no. 03/L-163 on Mines and Minerals, article 9 paragraph 1.7 of the Law No. 04/L-158 On Amending and Supplementing the Law no. 03/L-163 on Mines and Minerals and according to the Law on Roads 2003/11, the Board of the Independent Commission for Mines and Minerals in the meeting held on 16.12.2013, hereby issues this:

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION

ON DISTANCES IN REPORT WITH ROADS AND MINING SYSTEM

(ICMM NO. 03/2014)

Article 1

Purpose

Regulation, determination of adequate distances among roads and mining site or working sites of mining sector.

Article 2

Criteria

1. The criterion to determine the distances shall be determined according to article 9 paragraph 1.7 of the Law No. 04/L-158 On Amending and Supplementing the law no. 03/L-163 on Mines and Minerals and according to the law no. 2003/11 On Roads, respectively article 4 of this law..

Article 3

Roads Categorization

3.1. Roads network referring to this administrative instruction consists of:

- a) Motorways
- b) National roads
- c) Regional roads
- d) Local roads
- e) Residential roads
- f) Urban roads
- g) Connecting roads and
- h) Uncategorised roads.

Article 4

Distances allowed according to the roads category

- 4.1.1 Upon issuance of Licence or Permit the distance of mining activity from the Motorway shall be 100 meters for mining activity without blasting, whereas 500 m for mining activity with blasting.
 - 4.1.2. The distance from the National road, shall be 60 m with mining activity without blasting, whereas 500 with mining activity with blasting.
 - 4.1.3. The distance from the Local road, shall be 60 m with mining activity without blasting, whereas 500 with mining activity with blasting.
 - 4.1.4 The distance from the Residential road, shall be 60 m with mining activity without blasting, whereas 500 with mining activity with blasting.
 - 4.1.5. The distance from the Urban road, shall be 60 m with mining activity without blasting, whereas 500 with mining activity with blasting.
 - 4.1.6.. The distance from the Connecting road, shall be 60m with mining activity without blasting and with blasting.
 - 4.1.7. The distance from the Uncategorised roads, shall be 10 m with mining activity without blasting and with blasting.
- 4.2 If the licensee or permit holder wants to exercise activities that are included in Licence or Permit in any zone, that it is prohibited based on paragraph 4.1 of this Article, the licensee or Permit holder shall submit an evidence agreement-consent about exercising the activity in licence or permit by the institutions or “Responsible body for public road”

Article 5

Evaluation manner of Road Distances

- 5.1. Upon processing of each application the ICMM authorized officials are obliged to make the verification of roads in compliance with Article 3 of this Instruction.
- 5.2. After verifying and doing respective evaluation of the road then the recommendation shall be done related to road categorization on which road category is the application, for which the ICMM officials give evaluation.

Article 6

Entry into force

- 6.1. This Administrative instruction shall enter into force 8 days after its publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Kosovo.
